

# MSc in Advanced Practice (Screening)



1 Year (Full-time) / up to 3 Years (Part-time)

## Programme Aims:

Designed to offer a flexible, innovative and individualised educational opportunity to meet the requirements of health, social care and relevant professionals within a developing evolving health care climate. The programme will enable practising professionals from across the primary, secondary and tertiary care spectrum to demonstrate an increased level of competence through the development of advanced professional, clinical decision making and leadership skills which will enable the delivery of values and evidence based care that meets the health and social care needs of individuals, families and society.

## Programme Description:

The programme offers a specialist pathway in Advanced Practice (Screening). The programme is divided into modules that are credit rated. Each taught module offers 30 credits, with an optional dissertation for those who wish to move to Masters level. Students must complete four modules in the taught component of the programme; one of these is a compulsory research module and the remaining three modules are stated in the diagram below.
